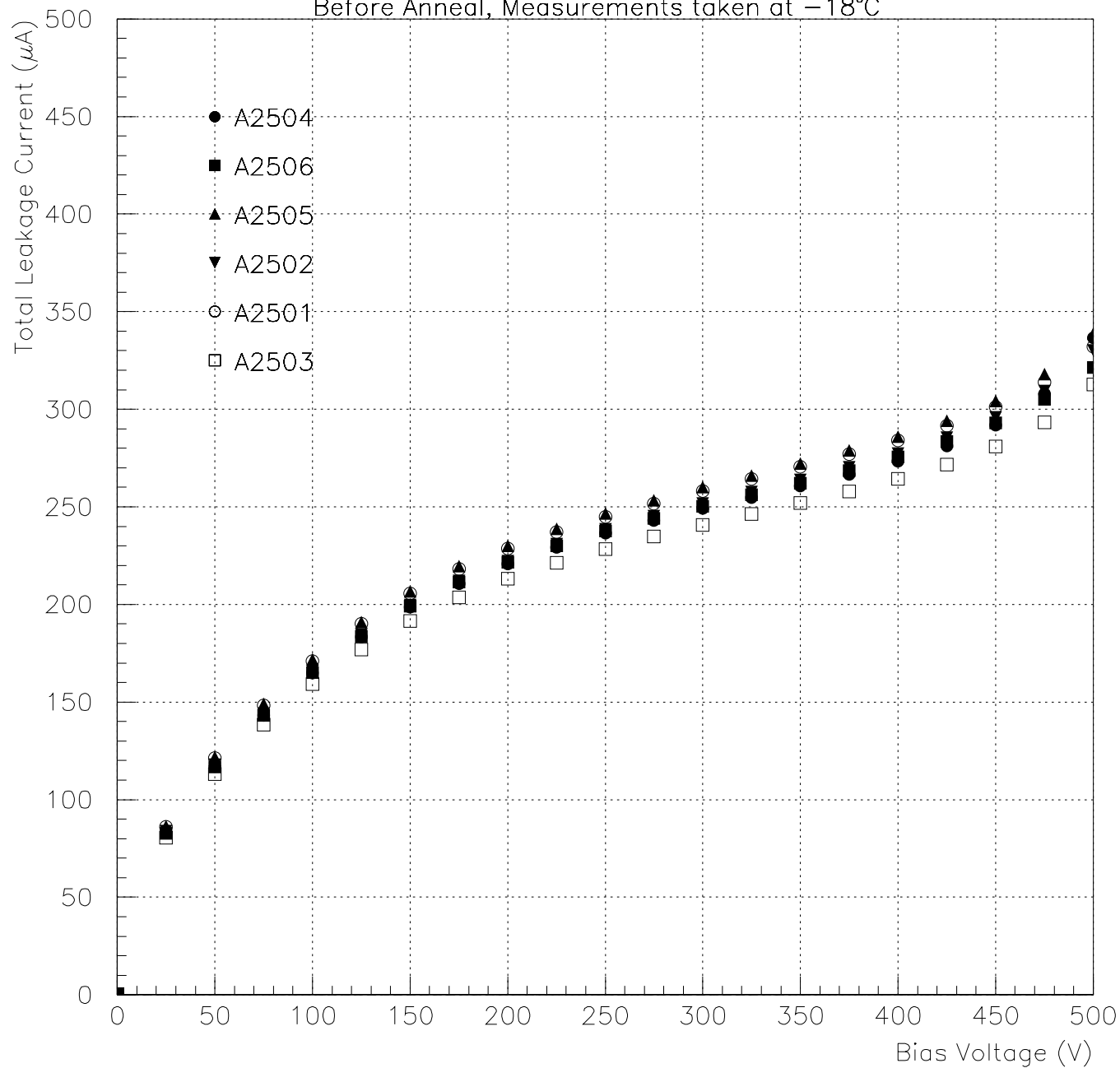

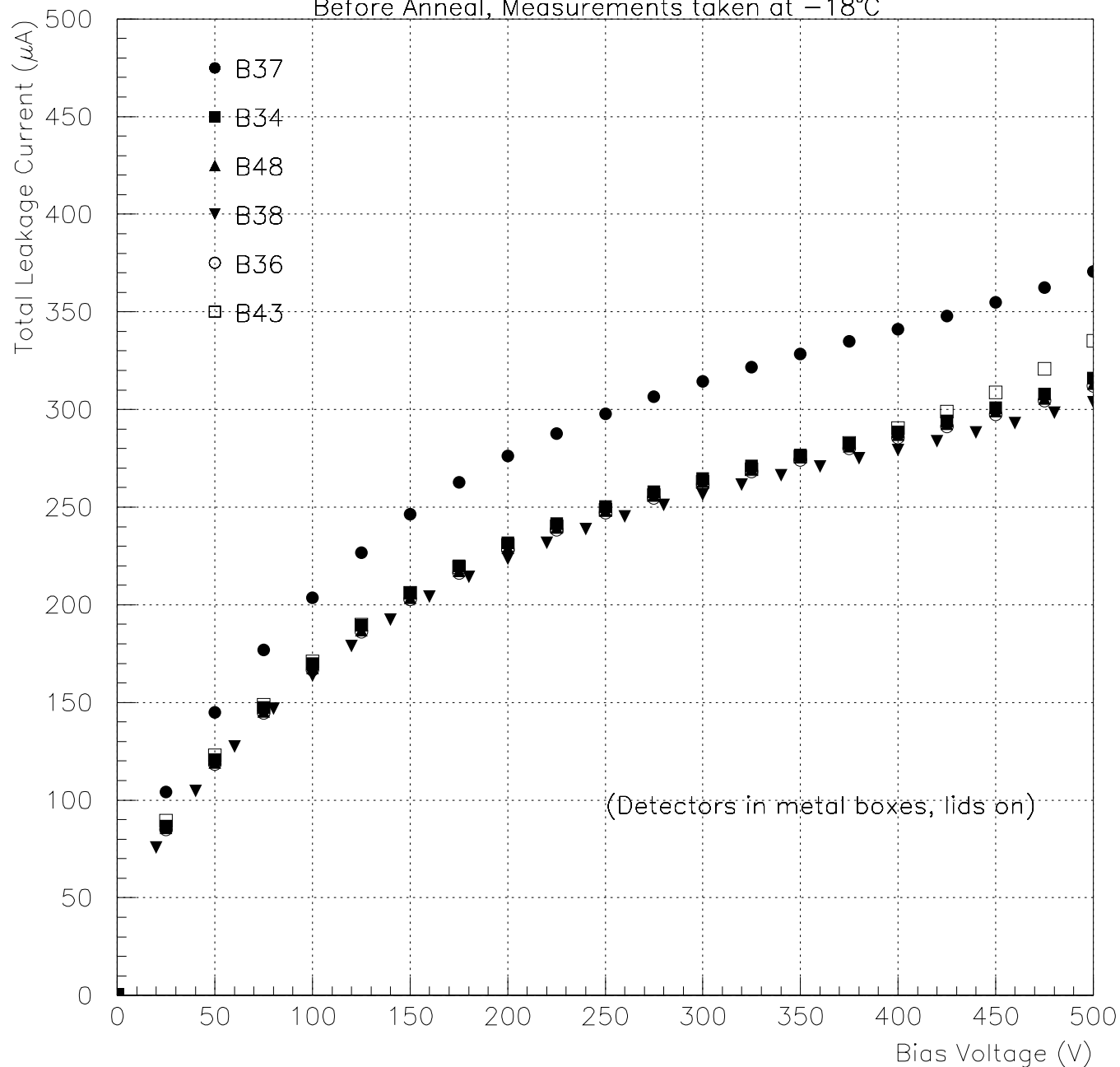

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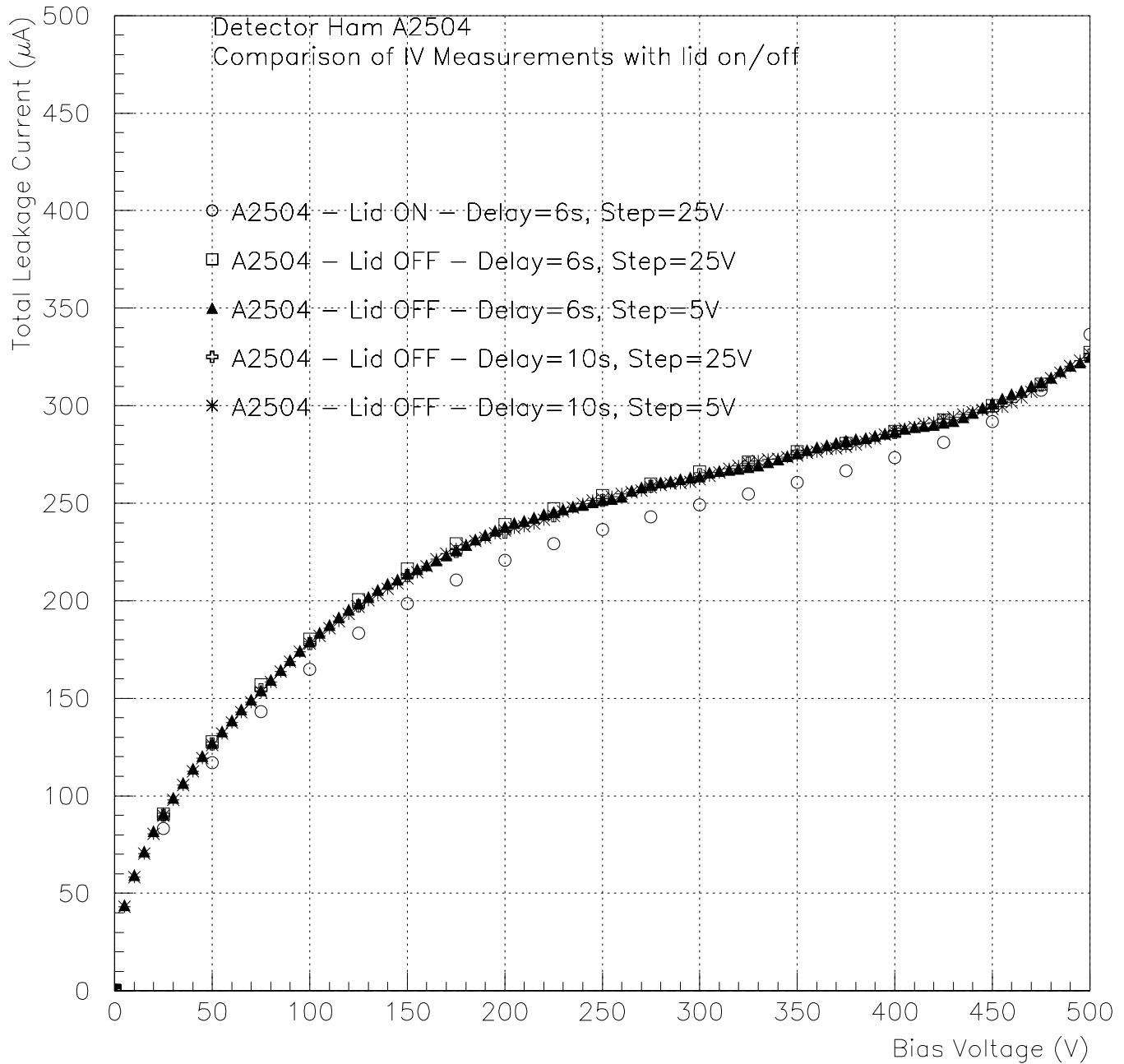
HAMAMATSU DETECTORS IRRADIATED JUNE 99
Before Anneal, Measurements taken at -18°C



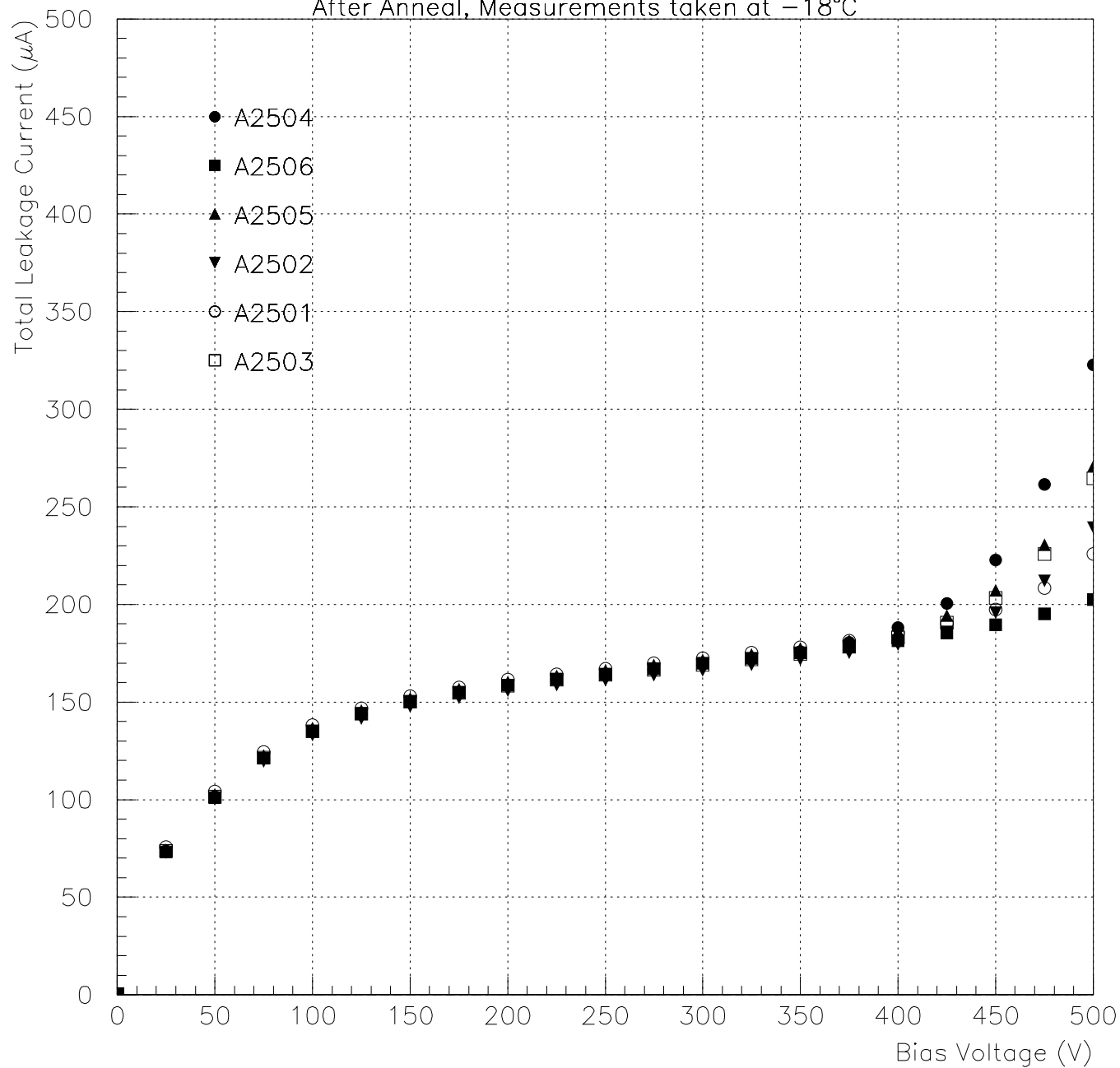

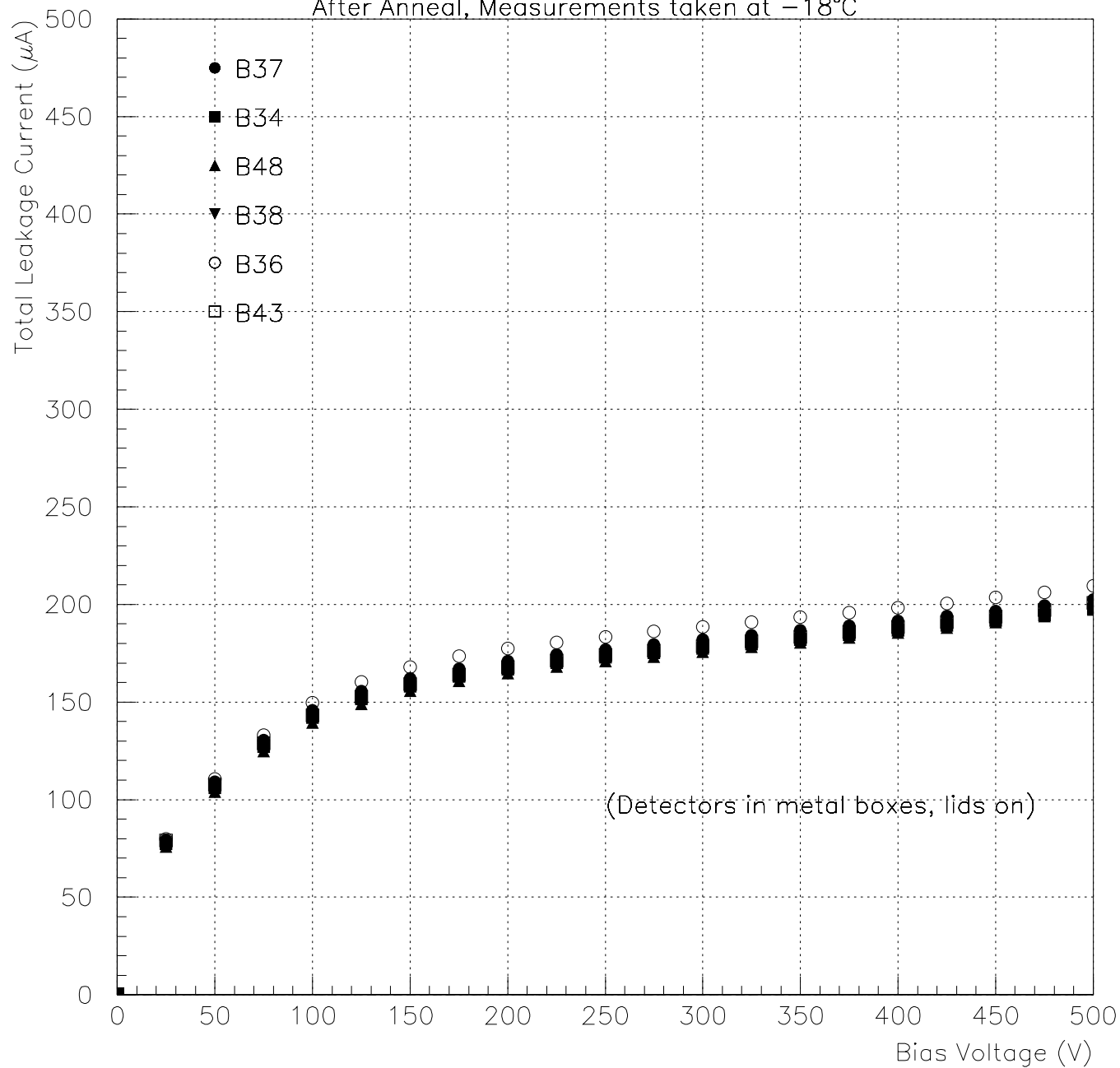
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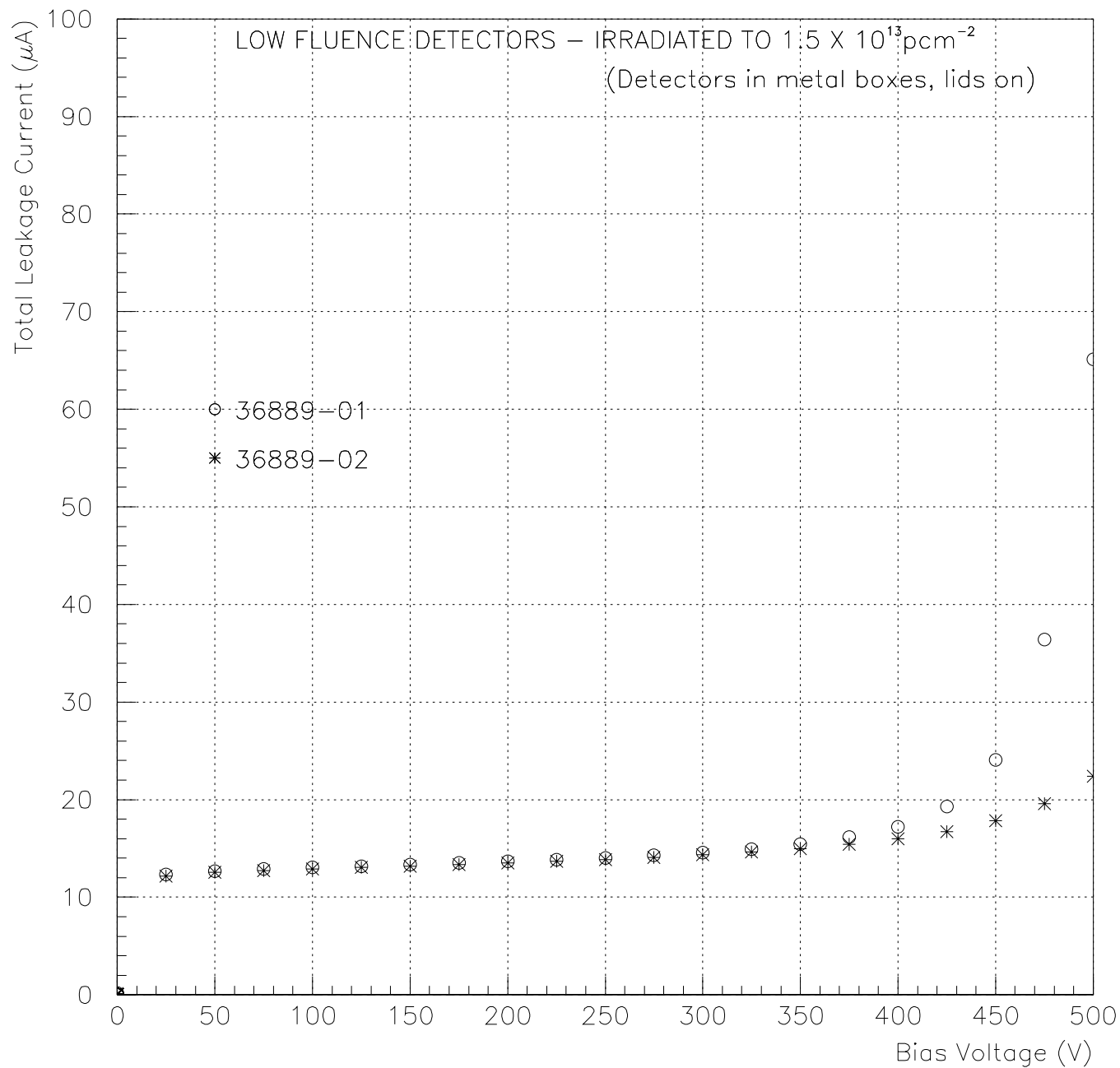


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
